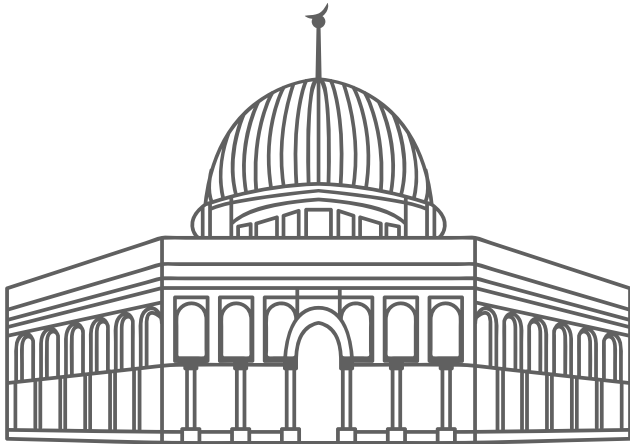
## *Important NOTE for parents/educators*
